



## Beach Area Lighting Restriction Affidavit

Pursuant to Section 161.163 of the Florida Statutes the Florida Department of Environmental Protection has designated certain coastal areas utilized, or likely to be utilized, by sea turtles for nesting, and has established guidelines for local government regulations that control beachfront lighting to protect hatching sea turtles.

City of Boca Raton Code of Ordinances, Sec. 23-242, was codified in accordance with these department guidelines and requires that glass that is visible from the beach, regardless of exposure, and including windows within doors, shall have a visible light transmittance of 45 percent or less. Tint performance claims which are supported by approved testing procedures and documentation must be submitted with the permit application.
